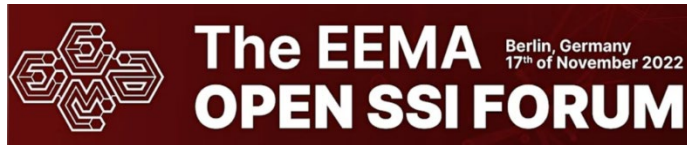


UBITECH participates in EEMA Open SSI Forum introducing the GLASS eGovernance paradigm
